

Rainbow Trout



Rainbow trout (*Salmo gairdnerii* Richardson). The rainbow trout is a very game fish, in back-country waters generally a better fighter than the eastern brook. During the height of the vacation season, hatchery trucks usually plant catchable-size rainbow at weekly intervals in most Inyo roadside waters. Another strain of rainbow, the Kamloops, prized by fly fishermen for its fighting qualities, has been introduced into Long, Sabrina, and South lakes in the Bishop Creek drainage.
